Dowd announces Democratic Campaign for Lieutenant Governor

"Enough is enough."

WIMBERLEY, TEXAS—Calling for a wholesale change in both the tone and substance of Texas politics and governing, Matthew Dowd today announced his candidacy as a Democrat for Lieutenant Governor.

Dowd, who has called Texas home for nearly 40 years and raised four children here, said his campaign will be based on restoring Texas values to the leadership of our state.
